TITLE: Motion Approving Agreement for Award of State Housing Initiatives

Partnership (SHIP) Funds for the Construction of Affordable Multi-Family Senior Rental Housing - Housing Opportunities, Mortgage Assistance & Effective Neighborhood Solutions, Inc. d/b/a H.O.M.E.S., Inc. - \$400,000

(Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, with Housing Opportunities, Mortgage Assistance & Effective Neighborhood Solutions, Inc. d/b/a H.O.M.E.S., Inc. to award State Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) funds, in the amount not to exceed \$400,000 for the construction of affordable multi-family senior rental housing.

Background

Annually, the City receives State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) funds from Florida Housing Finance Corporation for the development and preservation of affordable housing. On April 5, 2022, the City Commission approved the 2022 - 2023, 2023 - 2024, 2024 – 2025 Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP). The Rental Development Strategy contained in the LHAP allows the city to award SHIP funds to developers of new or rehabilitated rental units.

A parcel of land located at 1210 NE 5th Terrace, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33305 will be donated to H.O.M.E.S., Inc. by the City's Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA), contingent upon approval at the public hearing (CAM #24-0286), which is legally described as follows:

Lots 29, 30 and 31, Less the North 10 Feet, Block 113, PROGRESSO, according to the Plat thereof, as Recorded in Plat Book 2, at Page 18, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, Said Lands Situate, Lying and Being in Broward County, Florida (Property ID 4942 34 03 1890).

The SHIP funds awarded to H.O.M.E.S., Inc. will be used as gap financing to develop the parcel as affordable multi-family rental housing for low-income seniors, ages 62 years and older.

H.O.M.E.S., Inc. is a certified Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO) with a successful track record of developing and operating housing for low-income households for over 20 years.

On August 25, 2023, the Procurement Services Division issued Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 37. The following three (3) firms showed interest in the solicitation which closed on November 27, 2023.

- 1. Broward Housing Solutions
- 2. Housing Opportunities, Mortgage Assistance & Effective Neighborhood Solutions, Inc. d/b/a H.O.M.E.S., Inc.
- 3. Synergy Technologies LLC

The Procurement Services Division sent a reminder to Broward Housing Solutions and Synergy Technologies LLC informing them a proposal had not been submitted by either of them. The outreach effort went unsuccessful as both firms did not submit a complete proposal and deemed non-responsive.

On December 12, 2023, the Evaluation Committee met to evaluate the sole proposal from H.O.M.E.S., Inc. to ensure it met the evaluation criteria as shown in the table below:
