TITLE: Motion to Approve Consent to Assignment of Contract for Medical
Services to Occupational Health Centers of the Southwest, P.A. d/b/a
Concentra Medical Centers

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an assignment of contract, in substantially the form attached, for medical services from U.S. HealthWorks Medical Group of Florida, Inc. (“U.S. HealthWorks”) to Occupational Health Centers of the Southwest, P.A. d/b/a Concentra Medical Centers (“Concentra”).

Background

On November 17, 2015, the City Commission approved a contract with U.S. HealthWorks for medical services (CAM 15-1174). The initial contract term was for three years with two one-year renewal options. It is currently in the third year of the initial three-year term and is due to renew on December 30, 2018.

U.S. HealthWorks has assigned the contract, in its entirety, to Concentra. Concentra shall perform U.S. HealthWorks’ duties, obligations, and responsibilities under the original contract.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this action.
