A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPOINTING _____ TO THE POSITION OF CITY ATTORNEY OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, FOR A TEMPORARY PERIOD, ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE TEMPORARY CITY ATTORNEY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That _____ is hereby appointed temporarily to the position of City Attorney of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, effective April 3, 2018, retroactively, until further action by the City Commission.

SECTION 2. That the annual salary of the temporary City Attorney shall be \$_____, as adjusted by any subsequent general wage increases.

SECTION 3. That in the event the temporary City Attorney does not become the permanent City Attorney, he/she will return to his/her previous position of Assistant City Attorney III and his/her salary will revert to his/her regular rate of pay in effect on April 3, 2018, as adjusted by any intervening general wage increases.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall become effective on April 3, 2018, retroactively.
