Agreement for Seaglass: A Fort Lauderdale Rose Experience -

(Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approves a temporary beach license and outdoor event agreement with SEAGLASS GROUP LLC, in substantially the form attached, and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement.

Background

City staff has been working closely with the event organizer regarding event topics, such as logistics, maintenance, and security as detailed below. The Police Department recommends approval of the closing of City streets where appropriate with event parking being satisfactorily arranged. When applicable, amplified music was discussed, and the event organizer was advised of the noise ordinance and possible concerns.

The organizer will submit the required certificates of insurance. The organizer is requesting City Services to support the production of the event, as noted in the outdoor event application.

Civic and merchant associations have been notified, as appropriate, regarding events in their respective areas. Specific event details are included in each event application as attached.

Where applicable, the City Commission authorizes amplified music for the events listed below.

Authorization for the execution of the event agreement is contingent upon the City Attorney's Office receiving and approving a validly executed agreement.
