- TITLE: Motion Approving Agreement for the Purchase of Roll-off Dumpster Services - MST Scrap Metal Inc d/b/a MST Dumpsters - \$689,700 -(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase of Roll-Off Dumpster Services from MST Scrap Metal Inc d/b/a MST Dumpsters (MST) for an initial three (3)-year contract term in the amount of \$689,700; and authorize the City Manager to approve two (2) additional one (1)-year renewal options for an estimated annual renewal amount of \$229,900, for a potential total contract amount of \$1,149,500, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

The purpose of this procurement is for a service provider to collect and dispose bulky trash, construction and demolition debris, garbage, recyclable materials, and yard trash in its various sizes roll-off dumpsters.

On April 8, 2024, the Procurement Services Division issued an Invitation to Bid, Event No. 280, for the purchase of Roll-off Dumpster Services. On April 29, 2024, the event closed and a total of seven (7) bid submissions were received.

Two (2) bidders listed their status as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE).

MST met the solicitation requirements and is deemed the low, responsive and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

Funds in the amount of \$95,830 are available in the FY 2024 Operating Budget in the accounts listed below. Future years' expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budgets.
