- to have the foundation excavated so as to create ponding for mosquitoes and a haven for alligators;
- to have substantial mounds of soil loaded atop the seawall, accelerating its collapse into the New River.
- to have a mound of concrete debris stacked on the front of the property in plain view of the street.
- to have the once-substantial canopy of trees totally destroyed.

The structure's now uninhabitable condition is an unsightly and dangerous nuisance to the neighboring properties and causes insufferable devaluation of our own homes. Regrettably, the cost of repairing the damage and making this relatively small-sized structure habitable is now so significant that no buyer is likely to salvage the property and it will inevitably sit in its current condition for many years.





