TITLE: 2nd reading - Approve an Ordinance Amending the Name of the Middle
River – South Middle River – Sunrise Blvd Redevelopment Area
(MRSMRSB) Redevelopment Trust Fund to Include the supplemental
name “Central City Redevelopment Trust Fund”

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the second reading of an ordinance amending the name of the Middle River – South Middle River – Sunrise Blvd Redevelopment Trust Fund to include the supplemental name “Central City Redevelopment Trust Fund” which will be used in identifying the trust fund.

Background

On December 5, 2012 MRSMRSB Redevelopment Advisory Board voted to change the name of the redevelopment area to the Central City Redevelopment Area. In order to make this change two ordinances need to be adopted and a resolution passed to make the name changes as requested.

The City of Fort Lauderdale created the trust fund for accounting purposes. At this time the name change would only be applicable to the city’s identification of the redevelopment trust.

The ordinance attached to this agenda memorandum officially amends the name of the redevelopment trust fund from the Middle-River-South Middle River-Sunrise Blvd redevelopment trust fund to include the additional name of the Central City redevelopment trust fund.

A copy of the ordinance authorizing the change will be sent to the Board of County Commission and the Broward County Property Appraiser for their records.
