**TITLE**: Motion to approve increased expenditure for plumbing maintenance

services- Contract 402-10410 - \$30,000

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an increase in expenditure for the purchase of plumbing maintenance services to A-1 Paradise Plumbing, Inc. d/b/a Paradise Service Technologies in the estimated annual amount of \$30,000.

## **Background**

The City of Fort Lauderdale Parks and Recreation Department coordinates plumbing repairs and plumbing installations through the contracted vendor A-1 Paradise Plumbing. Staff originally estimated to spend approximately \$70,000 during the current contract period but due to many unforeseen repairs and installations, an additional estimated amount of \$30,000 will be needed for these repairs during the current contract period ending June 1, 2013 and increase the anticipated annual expenditure for the contract period beginning June 2, 2013 to an estimated annual amount of \$100,000.

## Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$30,000.
