

Recommendation

Staff recommends the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) Board of Commissioners approve a transfer of \$400,000 to the CRA Development Incentive Program to fund additional costs to Related FAT Village, LLC for the Gallery at FAT Village Project.

Background

On November 1, 2022, the Fort Lauderdale CRA adopted Resolution 22-16, including Commission Agenda Memorandum No. 22-0898. The adoption approved a Development Incentive Program Loan in the amount of \$1,500,000 to Related FAT Village, LLC for the Gallery at FAT Village Project located at 600 Andrews Avenue. The project now requires an additional \$400,000 commitment to fund the project.

The Gallery at FAT Village Project is a mixed-income development with one hundred fifty (150) rent and income restricted units, consisting of thirty-nine (39) units leased at 50% of the area median income (AMI), one hundred eleven (111) units leased at 120% AMI, and forty-five (45) units leased at market rate. The unit mix and allocation has changed.

The Northwest-Progresso-Flagler Heights (NPF) CRA received additional revenue above what was budgeted in Fiscal Year 2023. Of the amount received, staff recommends a reappropriation of \$400,000 to accommodate the additional costs needed to fund the Gallery at FAT Village Project. The total amended award will increase from \$1,500,000 to \$1,900,000.

Consistency with the NPF CRA Community Redevelopment Plan

The Redevelopment Program seeks to preserve and expand affordable housing, commercial development, and job opportunities. The NPF CRA Community Redevelopment Plan is designed in part to stimulate private development of areas. The Project is consistent with NPF CRA Plan which provides for direct physical improvements

to enhance the overall environment, improve the quality of life, promote public private partnerships, and investment in the area. In addition, per the Future Land Use Plan and CRA Plan, redevelopment and housing opportunities for low, very low, and moderate income household within the Northwest CRA should be encouraged.
