TITLE: Motion to award purchase of fire pumper trucks – Florida Sheriff's

Association contract 11-10-1202 - \$1,760,833.44

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a purchase of three Pierce Arrow XT fire pumper trucks utilizing Florida Sheriff's Association contract 11-10-1202 from Pierce Manufacturing Inc. in the amount of \$1,760,833.44, and authorize execution of the addendum to the contract between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Pierce Manufacturing Inc. for the purchase of fire pumper trucks.

Background

The Fort Lauderdale Fire-Rescue Department is in need of replacing old fire pumper trucks that have served their expected life cycle (per City criteria). These fire pumper trucks are needed to provide life safety and services to the neighbors and visitors of the City during non-emergency and emergency situations/events. The fire pumper trucks are utilized but not limited to aid for fire suppression, vehicle extrication, forcible entry, and basic and advanced life support medical calls.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(8) of the Code of Ordinances, this purchase will be made in accordance with Florida Sheriff's Association contract 11-10-1202 from Pierce Manufacturing Inc. in the amount of \$1,760,833.44, whereby such contract was entered into following a fair and competitive process that included public notice; sealed, written or secure electronic bid(s); and public bid opening.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$1,760,833.44.
