A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A LANE ELIMINATION ON POWERLINE ROAD TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) provides for an application process for lane elimination; and

WHEREAS, FDOT will be designing said lane elimination, if approved; based on applications submitted; and

WHEREAS, a Lane Elimination on Powerline Road will allow for buffered bike lanes to be installed; and

WHEREAS, FDOT will be implementing said lane elimination and inclusion of bike lanes as a part of the scheduled Restoration, Resurfacing, Rehabilitation (RRR) project on Powerline Road; and

WHEREAS, the project will aid in the implementation of the "We Are Connected" goal of the <u>Fast Forward Fort Lauderdale Vision</u> by improving transportation options including bike lanes and improved pedestrian accommodations; and

WHEREAS, the proposed projects implement the Multimodal Connectivity Program by increasing the connectivity for multiple modes of transportation; and

WHEREAS, the project is in compliance with the City's Complete Streets Policy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida does hereby authorize the proper city officials to submit an application to the Florida Department of Transportation for a Lane Elimination on Powerline Road north of Sunrise Boulevard.
