# **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2022 Not for Profit Grant Participation Agreement with Broward Partnership for the Homeless, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation, in the amount of \$50,000 and authorizing execution of the agreement.

## Background

With the adoption of the FY 2022 Budget, the City Commission approved funding to support contributions to not-for-profit organizations that support the needs of the community while making a positive impact. The benefiting not-for-profit organization is required to execute a participation agreement that provides for amount, terms of contribution, scope of services, and standards of performance.

The mission of Broward Partnership for the Homeless, Inc., is to promote independence and self-worth through advocacy, housing, and comprehensive services to reduce homelessness. The funding will be used to provide homeless individuals and families with access to washing machines and dryers at the Central Homeless Assistance Center (CHAC) located in Fort Lauderdale, lease of an off-site parking facility for use by clients, basic furniture and necessities for transitioning clients into stable housing in Fort Lauderdale, utilities for the CHAC, kitchen equipment to provide food services to clients at the CHAC, and air purification equipment for client dormitories and the cafeteria and clinic at the CHAC.

#### Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the General Fund in the amount of \$50,000 in FY 2022. Funding is budgeted and available in the account on the following page.
