

ORDINANCE NO. C-13-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SCHEDULE I OF THE PAY PLAN OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, BY CREATING AND ADDING ONE CLASS AND AMENDING ONE CLASS, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Director of Human Resources have recommended an amendment to the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, Pay Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission agrees with the recommendation of the City Manager and the Director of Human Resources to amend the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, Pay Plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Schedule I of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is amended to create, and add in alphabetical order by class title, the following class:

Class No.	Pay Range	M/C	Class Title
<u>168</u>	<u>M041</u>	<u>III</u>	<u>Chief Information Security Officer</u>

CODING: Words, symbols, and letters ~~stricken~~ are deletions; words, symbols, and letters underlined are additions; words, symbols, and letters double underlined are additions added after first reading; words, symbols, and letters ~~double stricken~~ are deletions from the version presented at first reading.

SECTION 2. That the following class, contained in Schedule I of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is amended as indicated, and inserted in alphabetical order by class title:

Class No.	Pay Range	M/C	Class Title
122	M041	III	<u>Police Information Technology Manager of Police Information Technology and Projects</u>


SECTION 3. That if any clause, section, or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning the first full pay period following its final passage.


