TITLE: Motion to approve the acceptance of additional grant funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security, Urban Area Security Initiative, State of Florida Division of Emergency Management through the City of Miramar, FY2008 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI), in the amount of \$48,781.34, no match required.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the proper City officials to accept additional grant funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management to execute any documents required to accept the additional funds between the City of Miramar and the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Background

The City of Miramar has provided additional Regional Citizen Corps grant funds to the City of Fort Lauderdale in the amount of \$48,781.34 through FY 2008 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program. The urban area is defined as Miami and Fort Lauderdale collectively. The sponsoring and coordinating agency is the City of Miramar, via a memorandum of agreement.

The City of Fort Lauderdale has received a sub-grant in the additional amount of \$48,781.34 with no required match. Funds will be used towards the enhancement of Regional Citizen Corps Volunteer purchases of equipment and training for Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) - (\$34,423.45), Medical Reserve Corp (MRC) - (\$4,412.69), Police Explorers (\$ 4,976.25), and Fire Explorers (\$4,968.95).

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$48,781.34. Funds are being appropriated through companion item CAM 13-028.
