TITLE: Motion to reject all bids for the purchase of Taxilane Charlie pavement
rehabilitation and replacement of airfield lighting – Invitation to Bid (ITB)
233-11237, Project P11749

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission reject all bids for the purchase of Taxilane Charlie pavement rehabilitation and replacement of airfield lighting and authorize City staff to rebid this project.

Background

The Procurement Services Division issued an ITB which contained conflicting bid opening dates. The bid documents listed the bid opening as July 10, 2013 and the City's electronic bidding software, BidSync, listed the bid opening as July 11, 2013. On July 10, 2013 the Engineering Division publically opened the bids that were received. On July 11, 2013 a contractor submitted one additional bid before the deadline stated in BidSync. That bid was the lowest price. Since there were conflicting dates in the bid documents and one bid was received after the public opening, the City's best and fairest option is to reject all bids and rebid this project. Staff therefore recommends that the City Commission reject all bids and allow City staff to rebid this project.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City.
