A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FINAL OPERATING BUDGET AND THE PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2014, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2015, BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS AS SET FORTH IN CITY COMMISSION AGENDA MEMO #14-1574 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 14-154, adopted on September 10, 2014, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale adopted the Final Operating Budget and Personnel Complement of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2014, and ending September 30, 2015,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:



**TITLE:** Consolidated Budget Amendment

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget.

**Background**

Budget amendments are consolidated into one agenda item for consideration at the first meeting of each month.

Examples of recommended actions within the consolidated budget amendment are:

- transfer between funds;
- transfer between capital and operating budgets;
- transfer between capital projects;
- acceptance and appropriation of grant funding;
- appropriation from fund balance; and
- appropriation for modified revenue and related expenditures.

Staff is recommending that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget and Community Investment Plan by approving the following transfers and appropriations:

## **Parks and Recreation**

### **A. Appropriation of grant funding – Grants Fund and Park Impact Fee Fund – Snyder Park Bike Trails - \$250,000**

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded grant funding in the amount of \$200,000 from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for the Recreational Trails Program Grant at Snyder Park. Funding will be used to develop recreational bicycle trails at Snyder Park as well as connections to the overall City's Multimodal Connectivity Program. This grant does require a cash match of \$50,000, which is available and has been identified in the Park Impact Fee Fund fund balance. The grant acceptance is a companion item on this agenda (CAM 14-1558).

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund and Park Impact Fee Fund in the amount of \$250,000 for the bike trails at Snyder Park.

### **B. Appropriation for modified revenue– General Capital Projects Fund – marquee with LED video display for Holiday Park - \$81,620**

A new electronic marquee sign will replace the existing 1950's static sign at Parker Playhouse and War Memorial Auditorium, located in Holiday Park. The cost to replace the marquee is \$163,240, of which, the Performing Arts Center Authority (PACA) will be responsible for 50% of the cost or \$81,620. The contract award was approved at the December 17, 2014 Regular City Commission Meeting (CAM 14-1517). This amendment is to allow for the receipt of the \$81,620 contribution from PACA.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the General Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$81,620 for the new marquee and LED video display at Holiday Park.

### **C. Appropriation from fund balance – Sanitation Fund – New boat, equipment, and 2 Municipal Maintenance Workers for canal cleaning functions - \$563,887**

Moving forward with the City's vision to improve access to waterways, an additional canal cleaning team is being put in place to support enhanced canal cleaning efforts. The cost for one-time equipment purchases is estimated at \$485,000 and the balance of the funding is required to hire two additional team members to perform the necessary functions. The one-time capital outlay is for a boat, a skimmer, and a trailer.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Sanitation Fund in the amount of \$563,887 and increase the Personnel Complement by 2 positions for enhanced canal cleaning services.

## Police

### **D. Appropriation of grant funding – Grants Fund – Operation Trend Buster IV Program Grant - \$43,114**

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded grant funding in the amount of \$43,114 from the U.S. Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) to continue the Operation Trend Buster IV Program. The program addresses underage sale/possession of alcohol, illegal club drugs, and electronic vapor cigarettes. Funding will be used for the rental of vehicles and staffing. There is no match required for this grant. The grant acceptance is a companion item on this agenda (CAM 14-1641).

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund in the amount of \$43,114 for the Operation Trend Buster IV Program.

### **E. Appropriation of grant funding – Grants Fund – Substance Abuse Prevention Program - \$72,557**

The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded grant funding in the amount of \$72,557 from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement to operate the Substance Abuse Prevention Program. The program, designed for middle school aged youth, promotes healthy alternatives to risky behaviors through life skills activities. The program provides over 1,300 hours of group instruction, events, field trips, and individual tracking of students enrolled in the program. The grant acceptance is a companion item on this agenda (CAM 14-1643).

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Operating Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund in the amount of \$72,557 for the Substance Abuse Prevention Program.

## Sustainable Development

### **F. Appropriation of grant funding – Central City Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) CIP Fund – Central City CRA area improvements, Broward Redevelopment Program – \$1.5 million**

The City Commission and the Community Redevelopment Agency Board of Directors approved an Inter-Local Agreement with Broward County at its respective meetings on May 6, 2014 (CAM 14-0514 and CAM 14-0515). The City was awarded funding from the Broward Redevelopment Program in the amount of \$1.5 million for improvement projects in the Central City CRA area. This grant required a cash match of \$310,000, which was appropriated with the adoption of the FY 2015 Budget and Community Investment Plan (CIP). The intent of this program is to replace aging public infrastructure, improve safety, lower transportation costs, promote economic development, and foster a greener environment. Projects approved for funding include roadway redesign, sidewalk replacement, on-street parking, bike racks, new tree

canopy, and ADA-accessible improvements.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2015 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Central City Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) CIP Fund in the amount of \$1.5 million for the improvement projects in the Central City CRA area.
