TITLE: Motion to Approve Acceptance of National Highway Traffic Safety Administration funds via the Florida Department of Transportation's 2014 Highway Safety Grant Program – \$72,759 and authorize the City Manager to execute the Sub-Grant Recipient Agreement

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an agreement accepting grant funds in the amount of \$72,759 from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration via the Florida Department of Transportation, 2014 Highway Safety Grant Program and authorize the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City.

Background

In February 2013, the City submitted an application to the Florida Department of Transportation for funding under the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's Highway Safety Grant Program. The overall goal of the grant is to assist safety-related agencies in the development and implementation of programs that address traffic safety deficiencies or expand ongoing safety program activities in safety priority program areas. Awarded grant funds will be used to support overtime for high visibility speed and pedestrian safety enforcement activities and to facilitate the purchase of safety educational and promotional items and three (3) speed measuring devices. The period of performance is March 27, 2014 – September 30, 2014.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$72,759. The grant does not require a cash match. Funds are being appropriated through companion item 14-0479 on the May 6, 2014 agenda.
