TITLE: Motion to approve proprietary purchase of Motorola annual maintenance

and support contract for 800 MHz (megahertz) public safety radio system -

\$349,765

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of Motorola annual proprietary maintenance and support, in substantially the form attached, for 800 MHz public safety radio system for an annual cost of \$349,765 from Motorola Solutions, Inc.

Background

On May 25, 1991, the City Commission awarded a contract to Motorola for the construction of a 26-channel 800 MHz public safety/public services radio communications system. Since system acceptance and warranty expiration, the maintenance has been renewed annually. The radio system is proprietary to Motorola, and only Motorola-trained and authorized contractors may work on the system for maintenance and repair.

Motorola's Service Agreement provides maintenance, repair and replacement service on the City's communications infrastructure, alerting systems and subscriber radios. The City's communications infrastructure consists of three communications towers, four microwave hops, 83 repeaters, 9 Fire-Rescue Station alerting systems, and 2,078 subscriber radios and related equipment.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$349,765.
