TITLE: Resolution approving a new Speed Hump Installation Policy

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a new Speed Hump Installation Policy (Exhibit 1).

Background

The revised Speed Hump Installation Policy reflects one element of the City's direction regarding traffic calming. The existing policy was originally drafted in the nineties (Exhibit 2).

It should be noted that the new Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Complete Street Guidelines and the City's direction of creating multi-modal pathways, bike lanes and shared use paths, includes speed humps as one component of available traffic calming measures.

City staff attended the November 2012 Council of Fort Lauderdale Civic Associations general membership meeting to present updates to this policy and to solicit input.

Staff then attended the January and February 2013 Council of Fort Lauderdale Civic Associations general membership meetings and received their consensus to the final revised policy. The revised policy includes additional criteria related to speed hump installation on streets adjacent to schools and parks as discussed at the City Commission Conference meeting on January 22, 2013.
