

RESOLUTION NO. 15-98

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA DETERMINES AND DECLARES THAT IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ORDINANCE NO. C-14-34 (HEREINAFTER, "MORATORIUM ORDINANCE") ON WIRELESS PERSONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWERS AND DISTRIBUTED ANTENNA SYSTEMS WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND RESOLUTION NO. 15-17 BY A TERM OF NINETY (90) DAYS BY THE AUTHORITY GRANTED PURSUANT TO THE MORATORIUM ORDINANCE AND THE CITY COMMISSION HEREBY EXTENDS THE TERM OF THE MORATORIUM ORDINANCE AN ADDITIONAL NINETY (90) DAYS TO AUGUST 8, 2015; REPEALING ANY RESOLUTION OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale adopted Ordinance No. C-14-34 on September 3, 2014 imposing a temporary moratorium upon the receipt of or processing of applications, permits or pending approvals pertaining to the installation or siting of any "telecommunications towers" as more particularly set forth therein (hereinafter "Moratorium Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Moratorium Ordinance had an effective date retroactive to August 19, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Moratorium Ordinance provided that it would remain in effect for a period of one hundred eighty (180) days from the effective date thereof, unless earlier rescinded, repealed or extended by an Ordinance or Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 15-17 extending the term of the Moratorium Ordinance by an additional ninety (90) days to May 16, 2015; and

WHEREAS, there is need for additional time to review, consider and modify the implementation of regulations pertaining to the deployment of such telecommunications towers and to evaluate the extent that the existing regulations are effectively regulating the deployment of such telecommunications towers; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the best interest of the City to extend the Moratorium Ordinance by an additional ninety (90) days to August 8, 2015;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the terms of the Moratorium Ordinance and Resolution No. 15-17, the City Commission hereby extends term for which the Moratorium Ordinance shall remain in effect for an additional ninety (90) days to August 8, 2015.

SECTION 2. That any prior Resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its passage.
