Water Taxi of Fort Lauderdale, LLC./Code Section 8-146.1

Attached is an application to transfer the existing water taxi license from Water Transportation Alternatives, Inc. to Water Taxi of Fort Lauderdale, LLC. The assets of the current operation will remain in place with the same number of vessels and currently designated routes. The City Code of Ordinances Section 8-146.1 authorizes the Marine Advisory Board to review and recommend to the City Commission submitted applications requesting authorization to obtain a water taxi license in the City.

Code section 8-146.1(b) requires that the contents of the application include at least the following: name, address and telephone number of the operator, including the names of directors, officers or partners where applicable; description of each vessel proposed to be utilized as a water taxi and a copy of the Florida Vessel Registration and the United States Coat Guard (USCG) Certificate of Inspection; a list of all pilots names and addresses including their employment histories over the past five years and their USCG license; berthing location of each water taxi when not in use; method of dispatch and location of the dispatcher; certificate of insurance coverage as required; and proof of required occupational licensing prior to operating. The City Commission, by motion, may grant or reject the application for a water taxi license based on the "applicant's demonstration that it has the proper equipment and personnel to operate a safe and high quality water taxi operation".

A Marine Advisory Board recommendation of approval for the license transfer to the applicant Water Taxi of Fort Lauderdale, LLC for City Commission review should include at least the following:

- 1. The approval be contingent upon the applicant being fully licensed to a operate a water transportation business in the State of Florida.
- 2. The approval is contingent upon the applicant meeting all minimal insurance requirements in accord with Code Section 8-146.1(b)(6).
- 3. All other licenses and certifications for vessels and vessel operators including required licensing fees in accord with the conditions of Code Section 8-146.1(a) & (b) remain in effect and full force prior to operation by the applicant.
