TITLE: Motion Approving an Event Agreement and Extended Road Closure

Beyond 10:00am on the Barrier Island for the St. Patrick's Day Parade and

Festival - (Commission District 2)

#### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an event agreement and request for road closure past 10:00am on the Barrier Island with Fort Lauderdale St. Patrick's Day Parade and Festival, Inc., in substantially the form attached, and authorize execution of the agreement by the City Manager.

## **Background**

City staff has been working closely with the event organizer regarding event topics, such as logistics, maintenance, and security as detailed below. Budweiser advised the committee at the end of December they were interested in bringing back the Clydesdales to Fort Lauderdale and they preferred the beach location. With the concern of the ongoing construction downtown, limited routes and a late addition of the Clydesdales, the St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee recommended changing the parade route to the beach.

Staff advised the committee that a new route would require Commission approval.

With the proposed new route, the Police Department recommends approval of the closing of the City streets where appropriate, and an event parking plan is being arranged. When applicable, amplified music was discussed, and the event organizer was advised of the noise ordinance and possible concerns.

In anticipation of the St. Patrick's Day Parade hosting this event on the barrier island, city staff has attended meetings with Beach Council on Friday, January 20, 2023 and Central Beach Alliance on Thursday, January 26, 2023 to discuss the parade and address any questions or concerns regarding the event. The Beach Council unanimously approved relocating the parade to the barrier island and the Central Beach Alliance approved as well.

The organizer will pay for all event costs and submit the required certificates of insurance. The event organizer will also secure all other necessary permits and licenses that are required from other agencies. Civic and merchant associations have been notified, as appropriate, regarding events in their areas. Specific event details are included in each event application as attached.

Where applicable, the City Commission authorizes amplified music for the events listed below.

Authorization for the execution of the event agreements is contingent upon the City Attorney's Office receiving and approving a validly executed agreement.
