**TITLE:** Motion Authorizing Settlement of Auto Liability Claims of Lazaro Diaz Risco, Mayra Perdomo Fee, Jose Angel Argueta Hernandez, Layma Diaz Perdomo, et al. – \$300,000 – **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

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**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve, as provided for by Sec. 2-151, Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the settlement of the auto liability claims of Lazaro Diaz Risco, Mayra Perdomo Fee, Jose Angel Argueta Hernandez, Layma Diaz Perdomo, et al., by paying the combined amount of \$300,000.

**Background**

Multiple injury and property damage claims were filed against the City as a result of a motor vehicle accident involving a City Police vehicle on March 18, 2025. The City vehicle was traveling westbound and entered the intersection of E Broward Boulevard and N Federal Highway while the traffic light was red, operating in emergency mode (lights and sirens). The City vehicle collided with a vehicle traveling southbound on N Federal, which had a green light, and that vehicle proceeded to collide with another vehicle stopped at the red light, traveling eastbound.

Pursuant to Sec. 2-151, Code of Ordinances, the claim was reviewed, and a settlement was recommended by the City's Risk Management Committee on August 28, 2025. Staff and defense counsel's evaluation of the potential financial exposure to the City determined that a settlement would provide the most cost-effective outcome.

Through negotiations, a combined settlement was reached in the amount of \$300,000, subject to the approval of the City Commission. The combined settlement amount will be divided as follows: Lazaro Diaz Risco will receive \$200,000; Mayra Perdomo Fee will receive \$70,000; Jose Angel Argueta Hernandez will receive \$25,000; and Layma Diaz Perdomo will receive \$5,000.

**Resource Impact**

If approved, there will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$300,000 which is available in the City's self-insurance fund account listed below.
