TITLE: Resolution Approving a One Year Extension to the Interlocal Agreement
with Broward County Transit for Community Bus Service for the Lease of
a Vehicle

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution and authorize the City Manager to execute a one year extension to the Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale for Community Bus Service for the lease of a Vehicle, per the terms of the existing agreement.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County are currently in an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) to provide Community Bus Services within the City of Fort Lauderdale as seen in Exhibit 1. The agreement defines terms and conditions of the use of the County vehicle. The bus is used on the Neighborhood Link Community Bus route.

The current agreement was approved by City Commission on October 7, 2014 and will expire on September 30, 2017. The agreement provides a base term of three years with two additional one-year extension options. Broward County has provided correspondence requesting that the City approve the first of the two one-year extension options, as seen in Exhibit 2, through September 30, 2018.

Resource Impact

There is no current fiscal impact to the City. There will be a fiscal impact to the City of \$10 annually for the lease of the vehicle which is funded from the Transportation and Mobility Department, Other Services Object Code TAM040101-3299 and subject to the approval of the FY 2018 Budget.

Strategic Connections:

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 1: Be a pedestrian friendly, multi-modal City.
 - Objective 1: – Improve transportation options and reduce congestion by working with agency partners.
 - Initiative 6: – Partner with agencies and businesses to increase commuter car-pooling and to incentivize and encourage mass transit use.
