TITLE: Motion Authorizing Settlement of Workers' Compensation Claim of Richard Willey - \$180,000.00

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the settlement of the workers' compensation claim of Richard Willey in the amount of \$180,000.

Background

Richard Willey, a Fire-Rescue Department community builder, filed a workers' compensation claim for injuries that occurred on February 25, 2007 and February 16, 2011, while in the course and scope of employment with the City.

Through negotiations, a settlement was reached in the amount of \$180,000, subject to the approval of the City Commission.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact in the amount of \$180,000 to the City.
