TITLE: Motion to set the public hearing dates to consider the proposed Fiscal
Year 2015 millage rate and budget for the City of Fort Lauderdale and
Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Wednesday, September 3rd and Wednesday, September 10th as the public hearing dates to consider the proposed Fiscal Year 2015 millage rate and budget for the City of Fort Lauderdale and Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District.

Background

Florida Statute requires that a public hearing on the proposed millage rate and budget be held within 65 to 80 days following the certification of the taxable values by the Broward County Property Appraiser (July 1, 2014). Municipal budget public hearings cannot be held on the same days as Broward County (September 9 and September 23, 2014) or the Broward County School Board (July 29 and September 16, 2014).

The City's proposed schedule for the adoption of its millage and budget is presented below:

August 4 – Public hearing dates, times and meeting places must be submitted to the Property Appraiser (required within 35 days of certification of value).

September 3 - Public hearing will be held at 6:00 P.M in the Fort Lauderdale City Commission Chamber to adopt a proposed millage rate and tentative budget by resolution.

September 6 - City will advertise its intent to adopt a final millage rate and final budget (required within 15 days of adoption of the tentative budget).

September 10 - Public hearing will be held at 6:00 P.M. in Fort Lauderdale City Commission Chamber to adopt final millage rate and final budget by resolution.
