Community Redevelopment Agency Fund Balance for Reallocation -

(Commission Districts 2 and 3)

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) Board of Commissioners approve the return of Central City Community Redevelopment Area fiscal year-end estimated fund balance in the amount of \$2,263,260 to the City of Fort Lauderdale for reallocation back to the Central City Community Redevelopment Area for Fiscal Year 2025 expenditures.

#### Background

At the end of Fiscal Year 2024, the Central City Community Redevelopment Area had an estimated year-end fund balance of \$2,263,260.

The City of Fort Lauderdale is the sole taxing authority contributing Tax Increment Financing (TIF) to the Central City Community Redevelopment Area. Subsection 163.387(7), Florida Statues provides the following:

On the last day of the fiscal year of the community redevelopment agency, any funds which remain in the trust fund after the payment of expenses shall be:

- (a) Returned to each taxing authority which paid the increment in the proportion that the amount of the payment of such taxing authority bears to the total amount paid into the trust fund by all taxing authorities for that year;
- (b) Used to reduce the amount of any indebtedness to which increment revenues are pledged;
- (c) Deposited into an escrow account for later reducing any indebtedness to which increment revenues are pledged; or
- (d) Appropriated to a specific redevelopment project pursuant to an approved community redevelopment plan. The funds appropriated for such project may not be changed unless the project is amended, redesigned, or delayed, in which case the funds must be re-appropriated pursuant to the next annual budget adopted by the board of commissioners of the community

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redevelopment agency.

Since the City of Fort Lauderdale is the sole taxing authority contributing TIF to the Central City Community Redevelopment Area, the CRA recommends returning the unspent paid increment to the City for reallocation back to the Central City Community Redevelopment Area to be used to further goals and objectives of the Central City Redevelopment Plan.

A portion of the funds reallocated to the Central City Community Redevelopment Area is intended to fulfill the funding needs for the NE 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue streetscape project. At the July 24, 2024 Central City Community Redevelopment Area Advisory Board meeting, the lighting component of the NE 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Project was presented and recommended for approval for a total of \$83,000. However, the project was presented for the second time during the March 5, 2025 Central City Community Redevelopment Area Advisory Board meeting requesting additional funds due to the formal bids being higher than initially estimated. The new estimated cost is \$211,000. This amount will cover light pole installation, fixtures, and wiring to the junction box. The project is expected to be completed by the end of Fiscal Year 2025.
