NEW CLASS – FEDERATION OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES

Class 167, Geographic Information Systems Analyst, L028 V, (\$59,321.60 - \$81,723.20)

This position is necessary to provide appropriate staffing in Information Technology Services to support the technical GIS needs of the City.

Background

This is responsible technical work in the support and analysis of GIS technology. Responsibilities include supporting the technical GIS needs of existing GIS customers, performing maintenance and update of GIS data, conducting spatial analyses, map creation, and automating repetitive tasks for improved efficiency. Additionally, this position analyzes and recommends improvements for GIS applications and GIS data to make available to the public, and develops and monitors data integration and updates between GIS and other City databases.
