Recommendation

Staff recommends settlement of this general liability claim in the amount of \$30,000 to Philomena Dibisceglie.

Background

Philomena Dibisceglie filed a claim for injuries sustained in a trip and fall accident on August 10, 2013. She was walking along the 300 block of A1A when she tripped on an unsecured metal electrical box cover when her foot struck a raised section of the cover. She sustained a fracture of her hip which required hospitalization and surgery, incurring medical expenses in the amount of \$79,335.57.

Her attorney filed a demand to settle in the amount of \$200,000. The City conducted pre-litigation negotiations and an agreement has been reached with Ms. Dibisceglie to settle this claim for \$30,000, subject to the approval of the City Commission.
