## **RESOLUTION NO. 23-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN EASEMENT IN FAVOR OF FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY OVER CITY-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 515 NW 15 AVENUE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE EASEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in order to support construction of a pump station in the Dorsey Riverbend community, the City needs to grant an easement over real property located at 515 NW 15<sup>TH</sup> Avenue (the "Property") to Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") for construction, operation and maintenance of underground electric facilities.

WHEREAS, granting the easement to FPL for the support of the construction of the new pump station located at the Property is in the best interests of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

- <u>SECTION 1</u>. The recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- <u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves the easement in favor of Florida Power & Light Company and authorizes the City Manager to execute and deliver the instrument.
- <u>SECTION 3</u>. That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by the City Manager.
- <u>SECTION 4</u>. That if any clause, section or other provisions within this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby but shall remain in full force and effect.
- <u>SECTION 5</u>. That all Resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- <u>SECTION 6</u>. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage.
