BACKGROUND

On June 6, 2023, the City Commission directed staff to process an amendment to the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) regarding the length members shall serve on the Planning and Zoning Board from three (3) years to four (4) years. Staff is also proposing to amend the length for the Historic Preservation Board from three (3) years to four (4) years given both are quasi-judicial boards. The City Commission expressed the desire to align board member term length with the length Commissioners serve a term, which is four years. The proposed amendments are attached as **Exhibit 1**.
