## SECOND AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR PARTICIPATING FORT LAUDERDALE UASI AGENCIES

This Second Amendment to Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort Lauderdale UASI Agencies (the "Second Amendment") is entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_20\_\_\_, by and between the City of Miramar, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida (the "Sponsoring Agency") and <u>the City of Fort Lauderdale,</u> a Florida Municipality (the "Participating Agency").

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency and the Participating Agency entered into a Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort Lauderdale UASI Agencies dated <u>October 24, 2011</u> (the "Primary MOA") related to expenditures of funds allocated in the amount of **<u>\$419,978.72</u>** subgranted to the Participating Agency under the FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative ("UASI") Grant Program, the initial term of which was to end on <u>June 30, 2013</u>; and which term has been extended through <u>July 31, 2013</u> by way of one previous amendment approved by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency and the Participating Agency entered into another Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort Lauderdale UASI Agencies dated <u>September 17, 2012</u> (the "Regional MOA") related to expenditures of funds allocated in the amount of **\$56,250.00**, subgranted to the Participating Agency under the FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative ("UASI") Grant Program for a regional project to fund: <u>The South Florida Citizen Corps Task Force</u>, to be expended and reimbursed pursuant to the terms of the MOA, the initial term of which was to end on <u>June 30</u>, <u>2013</u>; and which term has been extended through <u>July 31, 2013</u> by way of one previous amendment approved by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency and the Participating Agency entered into a third Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort Lauderdale UASI Agencies dated <u>January 22, 2013</u> (the "2<sup>nd</sup> Regional MOA") related to expenditures of funds allocated in the amount of **\$98,159.29**, subgranted to the Participating Agency under

the FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative ("UASI") Grant Program for a regional project to fund: <u>interoperable communications trailer radio system and data satellite</u>, to be expended and reimbursed pursuant to the terms of the MOA, the initial term of which was to end on <u>June 30, 2013</u>; and which term has been extended through <u>July 31, 2013</u> by way of one previous amendment approved by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the MOA(s) is/are subject to all terms, provisions and conditions of the Federally Funded Subgrant Agreement between the Sponsoring Agency and the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management for FY 2010 (the "State Agreement"), the current term of which will end or has ended on <u>June 30, 2013</u>; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency has applied to the State of Florida for an extension of the term of the State Agreement in order to provide additional time for the completion of procurement and the expenditure of the grant funding available under the FY 2010 UASI Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has agreed, subject to execution of a written contract modification, to reinstate and extend the State Agreement through <u>July 31</u>, <u>2013</u>; and

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to reinstate and extend the term of all referenced MOAs through the same extension date as approved by the State of Florida for the State Agreement, to wit: <u>July 31, 2013</u>, in order to provide additional time for the completion of the procurement process and the expenditure of the grant funding available under the FY 2010 UASI Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. In conjunction with the extension of the State Agreement through <u>July 31, 2013,</u> the term of referenced MOA(s) between the parties shall be reinstated and extended to <u>July 31, 2013.</u>

2. All terms, provisions and conditions of the MOA not inconsistent with this Second Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
