TITLE: Motion to terminate Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for Middle

River Terrace Addition OS-145.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion to terminate the agreement with Broward County for Middle River Terrace Addition (OS-145), located at 1325 NE 7th Avenue.

Background

The City applied to the Broward County Land Preservation Program to purchase the site to serve as an addition to Middle River Terrace Park. The .47-acre site, referred by Broward County as OS-145, is located at 1325 NE 7th Avenue. At the February 4, 2014 City Commission Conference Agenda (#14-0122), staff discussed with the City Commission regarding the termination of the agreement with Broward County for the Middle River Terrace Addition (OS-145).

Based upon that discussion, staff has worked Broward County to prepare for the termination of interlocal agreement for OS-145 (exhibit 1).

Staff is recommending termination of the interlocal agreement as provided by Broward County (exhibit 2).
