REVISED – **R-4** - Resolution Approving and Authorizing the Execution of an Eighteenth (18th) Amendment to the Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement for State Road A1A (Seabreeze Boulevard) with the Florida Department of Transportation for Improvements Within the Right-of-Way of State Road A1A (Seabreeze Boulevard) and Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement with TRR Bahia Mar Marine Marina Village, LLC, and Rahn Bahia Mar, L.L.C. - (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving and authorizing the execution of an Eighteenth Amendment to the Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement for State Road A1A (Seabreeze Boulevard) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for improvements within the right-of-way of State Road A1A (Seabreeze Boulevard) between Mile Post 2.396 to Mile Post 2.487 and an Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement, in substantially the form attached, with TRR Bahia Mar Marine Marina Village, LLC, ("TRR") and Rahn Bahia Mar, L.L.C. ("Rahn").

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale (City) entered to a Landscape Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the purpose of the City maintaining the landscape improvements within the right-of-way of State Road A1A (Seabreeze Boulevard), on January 31, 2008.

The eighteenth amendment to the MMOA (Exhibit 1) includes provisions to permit the construction of additional landscape improvements or to modify an improvement on State Road A1A (Seabreeze Boulevard) from Mile Post 2.396 to Mile Post 2.487, and in accordance with the plans attached as Exhibits "A" and "B" to the agreement. The Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement (Agreement) (Exhibit 2) between the City and TRR and Rahn passes the maintenance responsibility and costs associated with the MMOA to TRR and Rahn. TRR and Rahn agree to assume the City's obligation to maintain the improvements installed by them, in the right-of-way in accordance with the

agreement.

Resource Impact
