amount of \$200,000

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve one-year renewal agreements for general environmental engineering consultant services with the following firms in substantially the forms attached:

- 1) AMEC Environment & Infrastructure, Inc.
- 2) Environmental Consulting & Technology, Inc.
- 3) EE&G Environmental Services, LLC
- 4) E Sciences, Incorporated, and
- 5) Miller, Legg & Associates, Inc.

## **Background**

At its June 21, 2011 and August 23, 2011 regular meetings, the City Commission approved initial one-year agreements for general environmental engineering consultant services with the referenced consultants. In accordance with the terms of the contract, three one-year renewals are allowed. The City Commission approved the first extensions on May 15, 2012 (CAM #12-0879) and June 5, 2012 (CAM #12-0908). The City Commission approved the second extensions on February 19, 2013 (CAM #13-0252). This request is for approval of the third and final contract renewals.

#### **Resource Impact**

There is an estimated fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$200,000. Funding for these services will be from individual projects when services are contracted through individual task orders subject to the availability of funds.

The available funding identified in Exhibit 2 demonstrates the City's ability to fund the costs of these agreements.

Considering the approved 2014 Final Operating and Community Investment Plan budgets, the recommended agreements are estimated at \$200,000 in total.
