### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute a grant agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) on behalf of the City for the construction of the U.S. Customs & Border Protection Facility, Project 11242, in the amount not to exceed \$500,000 with a match by the Airport of \$125,000.

## **Background**

This project provides for the construction of a new single-story, 7,900 square foot, U.S. Customs & Border Protection Facility including: waiting area, bag inspection and queuing area, administrative office areas, interview/search rooms, restroom/bathing facilities, parking for vehicles including parking for the physically disabled, hybrid and carpool spaces, fencing and CCTV cameras, site lighting to meet City of Fort Lauderdale Code of Ordinances, emergency generator, irrigation and landscaping improvements, and sidewalk and accessible paths compliant with ADA requirements.

The facility has been designed to achieve Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certification in order to promote energy efficiency and reduce negative environmental impacts. LEED design and certification standards enhance the overall quality of the facility in addition to reducing operating costs, energy consumption, and impacts to the surrounding Airport environment. We anticipate obtaining a LEED certification of Silver for the building. The preliminary construction estimate for this facility was approximately \$4,887,950.

The Florida Department of Transportation initiated a multi-year Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) to provide funding for the construction of the above facility for up to 80% of eligible costs associated with the project. The FDOT provided a JPA in the amount of \$2,744,000, which the Aviation Advisory Board (AAB) reviewed at the February 23, 2012 meeting; a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) in the amount of \$885,000 reviewed by the AAB at the May 24, 2012 meeting; and a SJPA in the amount of \$81,250 reviewed by the AAB at the December 6, 2012 meeting. These three agreements were subsequently approved by the City Commission allowing the Airport to accept \$3,710,250 in grant funding from the FDOT with \$927,562 in matching money coming from the Airport Enterprise Fund.

The FDOT now has additional funds available for this project and has initiated another SJPA in the amount of \$500,000 requiring an additional \$125,000 in matching money from the Airport Enterprise Fund. This will raise the FDOT's total participation in this project to \$4,210,250 with matching funds of \$1,052,562 obligated to come from the Airport Enterprise Fund.

This item will be reviewed by the Aviation Advisory Board at its October 24, 2013 meeting.

# **Resource Impact**

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$500,000 for the grant revenue and a \$125,000 fiscal impact to the City for the required grant match.
