**TITLE:** Motion Approving an Agreement with the School Board of Broward County  
for Use of School Buses for City Recreational Programs and Events –  
June 1, 2022 – May 31, 2027 - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, with the School Board of Broward County for use of their school buses for programs and events from June 1, 2022 – May 31, 2027.

**Background**

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting authorization to enter into an agreement with the School Board of Broward County to provide bus transportation, when needed, for our recreational programs and events. As an example, this agreement could be used for transporting children on athletic teams or to special events. The City agrees to fully reimburse the School Board at the School Board's posted transportation rate of \$70 per hour and the bus attendant rate of \$28 per hour.

Pursuant to Section 2-176 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, the competitive solicitation process shall not apply to contracts with, and purchases from other public entities.

**Resource Impact**

Funds for this agreement in the amount of \$5,000 are available in the FY2022 Budget account listed below. Future expenditures are contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the FY2023 annual budget.
