Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution appointing Weiss Serota Helfman Cole & Bierman, P.L., as special counsel to represent the City of Fort Lauderdale in complex real estate matters.

Background

Section 4.10 of the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, provides, in part, that "[t]he city commission may, by resolution, authorize one (1) or more special counsel to be retained for the purpose of performing such legal duties as may be prescribed by said resolution. Each such resolution shall further prescribe the compensation to be paid the special counsel."

Due to occasional needs that arise from time to time, it is recommended that the City add to its roster of special counsel an attorney and law firm experienced in complex real estate matters. The purpose of this addition is to streamline the appointment process and to eliminate any delay in appointing and consulting with counsel in recurring complex real estate issues and matters.
