

ORDINANCE NO. C-25-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 15-57 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, BY CONSOLIDATING LOCAL BUSINESS TAX CATEGORIES, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, desires to amend Article II, "Local Business Tax," Section 15-57, "Amount of tax to be paid," of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, Code of Ordinances, to reduce the number of business tax categories by consolidating them;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Section 15-57 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Business tax receipts shall be issued to cover only one (1) location, and only one (1) of the occupations of business classifications hereinafter set out, unless permitted hereunder. Businesses, trades, professions, services, etc., shall pay each tax for all services and professions as noted herein. The amounts assessed as business taxes against the various trades, businesses and professions are hereby fixed as follows, with each listed fee in dollars:

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. That at the direction of the City Attorney, the publisher of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is authorized to conform chapter, article, section, subsection, clause numbers and letters, and capitalization, as set forth in the Code of Ordinances

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of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and to correct any non-substantive scrivener's errors in the codification of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon final passage.
