TITLE: Administrative Release of Liens for Community Housing Development

Organizations

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a Resolution allowing code enforcement and other municipal liens to be waived when a property is being acquired by a City approved Community Housing Development Organizations (CHDO's) under the HOME Investment Partnership Program.

Background

On April 6, 2010, the City Commission approved Resolution 10-97, which provides for the administrative release of certain code enforcement and other municipal liens for foreclosed properties acquired through the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP). Resolution 10-97 facilitated acquisition of properties through the NSP and it has allowed the City to surpass all of its NSP goals.

By building upon Resolution 10-97, the City will be able to assist our CHDO's and allowing them to acquire and rehabilitate troubled properties within the City of Fort Lauderdale.
