**TITLE:** Motion to approve corrective agreement with Sun-Bergeron for recyclables processing services – Piggyback Deerfield Beach contract ITB 2012-13/22

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a corrective agreement, in substantially the form attached, between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Sun-Bergeron for recyclables processing services.

**Background**

At its July 2, 2013, Regular Meeting (CAM 13-0928, Pur-10) the City Commission approved a five year “piggyback” agreement with Sun Recycling LLC, a Florida Limited Liability Company, and Bergeron Environmental and Recycling, LLC, a Florida Limited Liability Company, jointly and severally, d/b/a Sun-Bergeron, JV, based on a City of Deerfield Beach agreement pursuant to Code of Ordinance Section 2-181(7), in the annual revenue amount of \$479,880 (five year revenue amount of \$2,399,400) for recyclables processing services.

The agreement that was attached to the above referenced Commission agenda item has been corrected to amend the performance bond requirement, reducing it from 100% to 50% of the annual contract amount in order to conform with the performance bond requirement contained in the City of Deerfield Beach’s Invitation to Bid (ITB) that the City is piggybacking. Additionally, the corrected agreement incorporates, as applicable, addenda to the City of Deerfield Beach’s corresponding ITB and revises the numbering of the agreement accordingly.

**Resource Impact**

There will be no fiscal impact for this agenda item.
