A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY LAUDERDALE. FLORIDA. OF FORT AMENDING **RESOLUTION NO. 15-60 FOR PURPOSES OF INCREASING** FEES PAID TO MARK PURDY. ESQUIRE AND ROSE ANNE APPOINTED FLYNN. ESQUIRE AS DULY CODE ENFORCEMENT SPECIAL MAGISTRATES FOR THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, AND EXTENDING THEIR TERM OF APPOINTMENT.

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2015, Resolution No. 15-60 was adopted by the City Commission appointing Mark Purdy, Esquire and Rose Anne Flynn, Esquire, as Special Magistrates for the City of Fort Lauderdale for purposes of hearing code enforcement cases pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 15-60, the City Commission established a compensation rate of Three Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$375.00) for each appearance as Special Magistrate; and

WHEREAS, Special Magistrates Mark Purdy and Rose Anne Flynn have requested an increase of fees to be paid by the City for their service as Special Magistrates;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the term of appointment of Mark Purdy, Esquire and Rose Anne Flynn, Esquire as Special Magistrates for the City of Fort Lauderdale shall extend through May 15, 2017.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission does hereby increase the Special Magistrate hourly rate for Mark Purdy, Esquire and Rose Ann Flynn, Esquire to Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) for each Special Magistrate appearance for the first three (3) hours, plus an additional One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per hour for each additional hour. An appearance is comprised of pre-hearing preparation; appearing as Special Magistrate and hearing cases within a single day; travel time; and executing orders, whether at City Hall, or elsewhere. The new rates will take effect on final passage.
