RESOLUTION NO. 13-76

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A DEVELOPMENT PERMIT AND THE ALLOCATION OF POST 2003 DWELLING UNITS FOR A RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT AND PARKING GARAGE LOCATED AT 805 S.E. THIRD AVENUE, FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA IN A RAC-CC ZONING DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, an application for a development permit has been submitted to develop a project consisting of a residential development and parking garage which requires the allocation of 112 "post 2003 dwelling units", 100 of which will be designated as affordable units, at 805 S.E. Third Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida and located in the Downtown RAC-CC zoning district; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the criteria applicable to the Site Plan Level II approval, the development has been reviewed for consistency with the design guidelines or has proposed an alternative design which meets the intent of the design guidelines provided in the Consolidated Downtown Master Plan approved by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Development Review Committee (Case No. 36-R-13) at its meeting of March 12, 2013, gave preliminary approval, subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed the application for a development permit submitted by the applicant, as required by the ULDR of the City of Fort Lauderdale, and finds that such application conforms with the provisions of the ULDR as provided herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the application for a development permit submitted to develop a residential development and parking garage and the allocation of 112 "post 2003 dwelling units" at 805 S.E. Third Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida and located in the Downtown RAC-CC zoning district is hereby approved, subject to the conditions imposed by the Development Review Committee and City Commission.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That pursuant to the provisions of the ULDR of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the proper City officials are hereby authorized to issue the necessary building and use permits subject to the conditions imposed by the Development Review Committee and City Commission.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That this Resolution will take effect on the date a Declaration of Restrictive Covenants approved as to form by the City Attorney's office designating 100 dwelling units as affordable dwelling units and referencing this Resolution is recorded in the Public Records of Broward County, Florida.
