TITLE: Motion to award a one-year contract for Harley-Davidson motorcycle repair services - Invitation to Bid (ITB) 143-11349 - \$25,498.92

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a one-year contract for Harley-Davidson motorcycle repair services to the single, low cost, responsive and responsible bidder, Peterson’s Harley-Davidson of Miami, L.L.C., utilizing the City’s Contract (Form P-0001) in the amount of \$25,498.92 and authorize the City Manager to approve three, one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

The Police Motor Unit recommends awarding a contract to a firm with a certified Harley-Davidson mechanic to perform service and replacement of normal wear and tear of tires, brakes, clutches, running boards and annual interval checkup services as needed for the motor unit Harley-Davidson motorcycle fleet. There are currently 12 Harley-Davidson motorcycles to be serviced each year.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$25,498.92.
