1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving and ratifying a Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Federation of Public Employees (Federation) effective October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2028

Background

The current Federation CBA expires on September 30, 2025. The City and Federation began negotiations for a successor agreement in May 2025 and met six (6) times. Through these negotiations, the City and Federation came to a tentative agreement for a three (3)-year contract commencing on October 1, 2025, and expiring on September 30, 2028. The tentative agreement was presented to the Federation membership for ratification and Federation advised the City that the respective employees voted to ratify the agreement on August 13, 2025.

Resource Impact

The estimated FY 2026 impact of this agreement is \$2,367,771. Of this amount, \$11,681 is unbudgeted and will be incorporated into the budget changes proposed at the September 3, 2025 first public hearing.
