TITLE: Motion to award a one-year contract for pre-employment psychological

evaluations - Request for Proposal (RFP) 143-11344 - \$68,635

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a one-year contract for the purchase of pre-employment psychological evaluations to Harley V. Stock, PH.D., P.A., d/b/a Forensic Psychiatric and Psychological Associates of Florida, utilizing the City's Contract (Form P-0001) in the amount of \$68,635 and authorize the City Manager to approve three, one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department provides law enforcement services consistent with the needs of the community. Such services are directed toward creating and maintaining an environment that is safe and as free of crime and disorder as legal, ethical and resource constraints permit. Applicants for police employment are carefully and thoroughly screened, consistent with the requirements set forth in the Federal Uniform Guidelines on Employee Selection Procedures (1978), Florida State Statutes and Fort Lauderdale Police Department Standards.

The City began using psychological examinations as part of the Police Officer selection process in 1974. Approximately 255 psychological examinations are needed each year for Police Officer candidates and Police Reserve applicants. The timeline for this solicitation process included the following:

- January 2014 An RFP was issued for pre-employment psychological evaluations.
- February 2014 The evaluation committee, consisting of Captain Francis Sousa, Captain Reginald Gillis, and Captain Kevin Sheehan met with Michael Walker, Procurement Manager, to evaluate the two proposals which included the following firms:

- Harley V. Stock, PH.D., P.A., d/b/a Forensic Psychiatric and Psychological Associates of Florida
- Law Enforcement Psychological and Counseling Associates, Inc.

Including all evaluation criteria, the final tabulations were first ranked proposer, Harley V. Stock, PH.D., P.A., d/b/a Forensic Psychiatric and Psychological Associates of Florida and second ranked proposer Law Enforcement Psychological and Counseling Associates, Inc.

Among the reasons for Harley V. Stock, PH.D., P.A.'s top ranking was qualifications, knowledge of the City's working requirements, excellent references, and location of office.

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$68,635.
