TITLE: Motion Approving First Amendment to Agreement for Engineering
Consultant Services for Downtown Mobility Hub Streetscape Improvements
– **(Commission District 2)**

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a First Amendment to the Agreement for Engineering Consultant Services for Downtown Mobility Hub Streetscape Improvements (RFQ No. 12095-286), in substantially the form attached.

Background

On March 6, 2018 (CAM #18-0181), the City Commission approved a three-year contract, with two one-year renewal options for consulting services for the Downtown Mobility Hub project with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. However, due to a scrivener's error, the executed contract did not reflect the approved term of three years with two renewal options.

The purpose of this amendment is to add the term language to the agreement so that it is consistent with the language as set forth in the RFQ No. 12095-286 and the City Commission's approval on March 6, 2018.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
