

Please describe the reason(s) why you are seeking the street name change:

Mr. Raymond G. Christie was the second black "licensed" general contractor in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.
Mr. Christie was a well-liked businessman, Bahamian pioneer, and talented general contractor.
Mr. Christie built the Christie Grocery Store and several residential and commercial
"multi-story" buildings in the Dorsey Riverbend area. Mr. Christie played an integral part
in the development of the Dorsey Riverbend community. He loved his community and often Mr. Christie
would give away groceries to families in need. Mr. Christie has been recognized by the Old Dillard Museum
and featured in the Fort Lauderdale International Film Festival (FLIFF) Award-Winning documentary
titled "Crossing the Waters: The Impact of Bahamian Pioneers in South Florida."

Dear City of Fort Lauderdale:

It is my privilege to submit this letter on behalf of Fort Lauderdale pioneer Mr. Raymond George Christie. Mr. Christie was a Bahamian, a licensed general contractor, a real estate developer, and a businessman owning the popular "Christie Grocery Store," established in 1957 in the Dorsey River Bend area. Raymond G. Christie was the second black licensed general contractor in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. As early as the 1950s, Mr. Christie built on the "beach side" of Fort Lauderdale as well as commercial and residential buildings in the N.W. Fort Lauderdale area. To his credit, Mr. Christie built notable structures such as the Sunland Park (now known as Carter Park) pool house and library, The Roy Mizell Funeral Home, the T.J. Reddick Building, and one very special multistory building, the "Christie Grocery Store." Local families in the Dorsey River Bend area would shop for groceries, and in many cases, Mr. Christie would give groceries away to families in need. Christie was no stranger to the Jewish community and frequently he would work with Jewish real estate investors such as Joseph Popkin, Joseph Levine, Vic Zeve, and Lewis Chester. Mr. Raymond G. Christie was well-loved and he loved the Dorsey River Bend community. I ask that you please rename NW 19th Ave in his honor as "**Raymond G. Christie Avenue.**" Mr. Christie is most deserving!

RAYMOND GEORGE CHRISTIE

Raymond George Christie (January 5, 1918 - April 10, 1991) was a prominent businessman, contractor, and real estate developer. Raymond Christie was born in Nicholls Town located in Andros, Bahamas. Christie immigrated to the United States on an immigration contract in 1941 and settled in Fort Lauderdale, Florida in 1946. Eventually, Christie became a U.S. citizen in 1954.

Christie was a well-liked businessman and a talented licensed general contractor for residential and commercial properties. One very special multistory building that the black community loved and often visited was "The Christie Grocery Store," which is connected to the RGC Christie apartments. Christie's grocery store was an integral part of the black community in Fort Lauderdale, FL, and many young black children would love to go to the Christie grocery store to buy a "big cookie" for a penny. Along with this, local families would shop at the Christie grocery store for groceries, and in many cases, Mr. Christie would give away groceries to families in need of food. In addition, Christie built numerous properties in the black community as a prominent real estate developer in the Broward County area. In particular, he built several commercial buildings along NW 6th Street/Sistrunk Blvd. and contributed to the development of the Dorsey Riverbend area by building apartments and homes for this historic black community. As a prominent contractor, Christie was continuously sought out to build multi-story apartments, homes, and commercial buildings to enhance and help build up the black community. Christie was also no stranger to the Jewish community and frequently worked with Jewish real estate investors such as Joseph Popkin, Joseph Levine, and Vic Zeve.

Christie married his beautiful wife Marion in 1947 and to this union, seven children were born. The RGC Building remains on Sistrunk Blvd., in Fort Lauderdale and is still a commercial business enterprise operated and maintained by Mr. Christie's children. Overall, Christie was a visionary leader keen on construction, real estate, and community development.

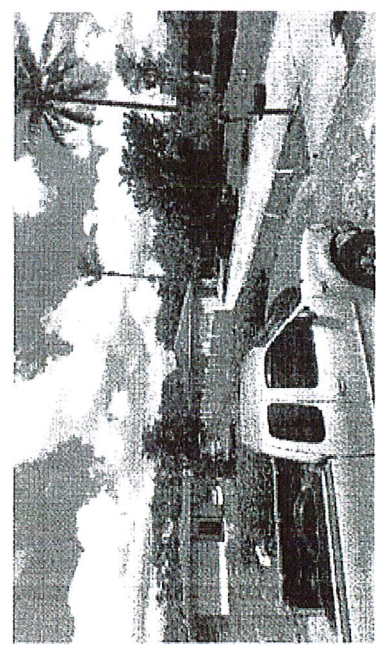




