TITLE: Motion Approving Florida Department of Transportation Occupant
Protection Program Funding - \$78,000 -**(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and
4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a subgrant agreement from the Florida Department of Transportation to assist the police department in conducting a public awareness and enforcement campaign related to safety belt usage.

Background

In February 2025, the City applied to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in response to a solicitation for proposals from law enforcement agencies to address traffic safety concerns within their jurisdictions. The City has been awarded \$78,000 in funding to implement an occupant protection safety campaign to reduce the frequency of incidents in identified hot spots. The campaign will include a combination of enforcement efforts and educational outreach. The funding may also be used to acquire a message board trailer to display traffic safety messages. No local match is required, and the grant period ends on September 30, 2026.

Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$78,000. This item is contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment (CAM #26-0059).
