A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A FY 2026 NOT FOR PROFIT SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH EXPERIENCE AVIATION, INC., AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE PROGRAM SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH EXPERIENCE AVIATION, INC. ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport ("FXE") is one of the top five largest executive airports in the country and supports over 23,000 jobs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale would like to launch a Pre-Apprenticeship and Workforce Development STEM Program with Barrington Irving Technical Training School ("BITTS") at FXE for high school students and adults living in the City; and

WHEREAS, this program will provide a workforce education program that provides jobs for city residents in the aviation, automotive, and marine industries; and

WHEREAS, the City's Education Advisory Board has researched and communicated to the City Commission their support for this program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission approves an FY 2026 Not For Profit Service Agreement with Experience Aviation, Inc., in substantially the form attached to City Commission Agenda Memorandum 25-1085, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the FY 2026 Not For Profit Service Agreement on behalf of the City.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That if any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
